

Junee Preschool Response to CoVID 19 pandemic

These planned measures to respond to the CoVID 19 pandemic are current as of 30 January 2023 in line with the Department of Education. They will be continually reviewed and updated to remain in-line with information from the Department of Health and Department of Education.

Stage	Measures to be implemented
1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Parents/Carers will be able to enter the preschool to enter their child's room upon drop off & collection. * Child/staff members displaying signs of respiratory illness will need to stay home/be collected. * Storage of water bottles to in drink bottle holders in order for them to remain separated.
2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * 1 Parent/Carer to drop off and pick up from the decks outside each room. Masks are no longer mandatory for parents or staff, however its up to your discretion if you chose too. * Existing hygiene practices increased in frequency (eg, hand washing, cleaning of bathrooms, cleaning of equipment). * Education around hygiene practices increased. * Staff/students who show signs of respiratory (cold or flu-like) symptoms to be excluded until tested for CoVID19 and recovered. * Visitors (other than those necessary for the day to day running of the Preschool) to be restricted. Sign put on the gate to call before entering. * Excursions/ events to be cancelled until threat of pandemic is deemed over.
3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * 1 Parents/carer are to drop off and pick up at the front gate and not enter the indoor area of the service. * Families should maintain physical distancing at the front gate of the service whilst wearing a mask. * If you need to enter the service you must sign in using the NSW QR code which will be displayed at the gate and show proof of double vaccination. * After any absences, families will be asked where they have been recently to identify anyone coming from CoVID hotspots. * Advise families with members whose immune systems are

	<p>compromised to stay home.</p> <p>* Advise families that if they feel uncomfortable, that they are welcome to keep their children at home.</p>
4	<p>* Families will be asked to keep children away from Preschool unless they have no alternative care.</p> <p>* Preschool will operate with a skeleton staff, with some staff members working from home to provide online learning content.</p>
5	<p>* The Preschool will be closed to staff and students until further notice.</p>
